WEEKLY USA GRAIN AND PROTEIN REPORT March 16, 2024

Soybeans had another up week this week with prices moving about USD 6 m/t higher while soymeal prices slipped by about the same amount. Corn prices did little on the week finishing about the same as the previous week. All US wheat prices were lower with hard red winter and hard red spring wheat both being down by USD 5 to 7 m/t.

Soybean prices finished the week higher due to some "uncertainty" about the Brazil soybean crop that appeared during the week. Soybean prices seem to be trading in a range these days, but it does not look like there is any trend to higher price levels for now.

Corn prices were up just a little as the week closed pushed higher experts say by the dry weather seen in the corn belt. Reports say that it has been the driest winter in 21 years with 72% of the US Midwest being very dry.

USA wheat prices continued to move lower as they followed what was happening in all the world's wheat export markets. Major wheat importing countries have been out of the market as they expect even lower prices to come.

SECTION 2 --- FISHMEAL COMMENTS AND PRICES: PERUVIAN "INDICATION" FISHMEAL PRICES:

Fishing has started in the south of Peru but so far only less than 100 m/t reported landed.

Not much to say about new business in Peru as both buyers and sellers are out of the market for now. There has been no change in Peru fishmeal prices.

Everyone is still hoping that the new North/Central Peru fishing can begin in late April but perhaps May.

Still, lots of talk about El Nino/La Nina but as we have seen for weeks there does not seem to be much to worry about until much later in 2024 --- all looks well, according to the experts, until at least August.

There is lots of reported pressure on the Peru government to change its size definition for juvenile anchovy – the industry wants the minimum size decreased from 12 cm to 10.5 cm which would certainly increase the catch during the fishing season.
