WEEKLY USA GRAIN AND PROTEIN REPORT April 13, 2024

This week was USDA WASDE week and prices didn't seem to get too excited after the report. Most experts felt that the report was bearish for US grains and oilseeds due to higher than expected carryover stocks of all items.

The USDA made almost no change in world stocks numbers from the last report.

Corn prices were down on the week by about USD 4 to 5 m/t but there didn't seem to be much reason for lower prices as most experts felt that the WASDE was quite neutral for corn. So, it seems that it was just a little emotion that pushed corn lower as the week ended.

Soybeans had a down week all week with market prices ending up down by more than USD 10 m/t – everyday this week soybeans slipped lower. The WASDE report didn't make any serious changes to US numbers so the soybean market is just a bearish market with little WASDE effect. Soymeal prices were actually up in the week by about USD 5 m/t.

After the WASDE report all wheat prices dropped lower by USD 3 to 6 m/t, depending on the type. Wheat had looked to want to go higher this week as a result of the drought in the wheat belt but the small bearish changes made by the WASDE seemed to get the market in the mood for lower prices. The general feeling is that US wheat prices should move higher if the lack of rainfall continues.

SECTION 2 --- FISHMEAL COMMENTS AND PRICES: PERUVIAN "INDICATION" FISHMEAL PRICES:

So now we have a new fishing quota and a pretty impressive quota it is --- 2,475,000 m/t of catch which should yield about 590,000 m/t of fishmeal. Fishing under the new North/Central quota begins on April 16, 2024.

There doesn't seem to have been any change in prices after the quota was announced although trade reports say that the Chinese have lowered their bid prices.

Trade reports this week also mentioned that the juvenile level remains very high in some of the fishing areas which will probably mean a good number of mini fishing bans once the catch gets started.

It is expected that not much will happen with prices until we have seen some fishing in order to determine exactly what the fishing conditions are and how the catch is.
